### **MPART update**

- MDEQ reported AECOM completed public water sampling in Kent County. Otsego and Plainwell public water sampling next week.
  - Soil sampling in Lapeer County began this week.
  - Residential well sampling will start next week in Battle Creek.
- MDEQ reported Plainfield pilot project has started.
  - Installing Granular Activated Carbon treatment system
  - Results available in 4-6 weeks.
- Request from MALEHA to be part of the Local Health Department Advisory Committee to MPART.
- USDA funding available for local communities' municipal hookup related to PFAS contamination.
  - Short application window.
  - Want to make sure eligible communities take advantage of opportunity.
- MDEQ shared that Steve Silver will be taking over for Sue Leeming on day to day PFAS response.
