DHD4 Continues to Add COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics

From Dec. 18th through January 15th, District Health Department No. 4 (DHD4) had enough vaccine to administer 927 doses to residents in Alpena, Cheboygan, Montmorency and Presque Isle counties. On January 18 & 19, alone, DHD4 staff and volunteers administered close to 1,600 doses of COVID19 vaccines in Alpena and Cheboygan counties.

DHD4 has added additional COVID-19 Vaccination dates and continue to focus on the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services priority groups which are:

- People age 65 years or older
- Frontline, essential workers that includes first responders, police officers, jail and prison staff, pre-K-12 teachers and childcare providers are included.
- 1A healthcare workers

There are well over 25,000 residents eligible for vaccine in DHD4 jurisdiction.

An appointment is required. Please do not show up without an appointment.

January 26th at Cheboygan Knights of Columbus Hall

January 27th at the Eagles Club, Atlanta, MI

January 28th at the Alpena Mall

January 29th at the Case Township Community Center in Millersburg

DHD4 staff and volunteers will be scheduling for these clinics from the online pre-registration forms received. We ask that those who can pre-register online to please do so at www.dhd4.org/covid19vaccine. Please note that if you receive a "Thanks for submitting" message you are in the vaccination queue. You will not receive a confirmation email or call. Do not call to confirm your online pre-registration as it ties up phonelines for those that cannot register online. If you cannot register online continue to call 989-356-4507 and choose option #1.

If you are eligible for vaccination, it does not mean vaccination is immediately available to you. Over 6,000 individuals NE Michigan have already pre-registered to receive the COVID-19 vaccine, however the current vaccine supply does not meet this demand. DHD4 thanks you for your patience as we plan through all of the complexities of changing guidance and limited vaccine allocations.
